



GENERAL NOTES

The book HORIZONS by Norman Bel Geddes (copyright 1932) includes information about this airplane in Chapter 5 "By Air To-morrow". The chapter is about 40 pages, and there are also images on pages 110-120. Included in those pages are drawings of some of these decks. Some, not all.

The details of the decks not shown can be deduced from the text in the chapter. The text also helps to clarify the details that are shown. Most of the "Notes For Deck X" (on these pages) are from that chapter. The crew breakdown, specifications, list of features, etc are also from Norman's book.

The details shown on the deck plans in the book do not align with each other. Also, external features do not align with the internal details.

Finally, some of the descriptions in the text cannot possibly be reconciled to fit within the layout shown of this airplane.

Structural details are missing. Not enough space has been set aside for piping, wiring, ducts, etc.

There is probably enough space set aside for fuel, water, food, etc but not enough to also support the 6 lifeboats and the 2 small airplanes. The 6 lifeboats cannot carry 120 passengers - each - let alone food, water and fuel for 2 weeks (as stated in the book).
